2025 Scholarship Application

The Lafayette Chapter of Credit Unions is pleased to announce that it will offer three \$1000 scholarships in 2025. Entries are accepted from eligible credit union members. This scholarship is awarded through a random drawing among eligible applicants.



Eligibility

To be considered for the chapter scholarship, you must:

- Be a member of one of the participating credit unions.
- Be graduating from high school in the spring of 2025, or currently enrolled in undergraduate studies at an accredited college, university, or technical school or with plans to attend an accredited college, university, or technical school full-time in the fall of 2025.
- Have maintained a 3.0 GPA based on 6 high school semesters or 1 most recent, completed college semester.
- Have scored a 21 or higher on the ACT exam.
- Complete an application and personal essay.

Immediate family members of current employees and Board of Directors of any of the participating credit unions **ARE NOT** eligible for the scholarship.

Application Package

All applicants must submit a package, which includes:

- A completed application.
- A current high school transcript or college transcript.
- A copy of your official ACT or SAT results.
- Two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a teacher from your junior or senior year (only applies to high school seniors), or your current college professor or advisor.
- A personal essay.
